

Club Rules

Beach Regulations:

- a. **Every member is responsible for keeping the beach and facilities clean.**
 - i. Garbage must not be left at the beach facilities.
 - ii. Members and Guests are responsible for picking up the toys used by their children.
 - iii. Club owned chairs, umbrellas, and other furniture kept in the shed must be put away after use.
 - iv. Everyone who uses a club grill is responsible for cleaning and putting it away if it is not one of the anchored types.
- b. To avoid conflicts, if a member is hosting an event at the beach they should inform the Club President so it can be placed on the event calendar located in the cabana. Tom Sochor should be made aware to add it to the website.
- c. Hours of use for the beach shall be from 6.00 a.m. to 12:00 a.m. The Club President must approve all exceptions, to extend beyond 12:00 a.m.
- d. Members are encouraged to participate in one workday per year.
- e. **On high use days of the beach, such as Saturdays, Sundays, and Holidays during the summer months, only one car per family should be brought to the beach.** Please park in a neat and orderly manner to accommodate more cars. The boat ramp access way should not be used as a parking place, if it is necessary to park there, please be prepared to move your car in event of a Member wanting to use the ramp.
- f. Children are not allowed to play in the Cabana.
- g. **PER THE 2021 ANNUAL MEETING, "MEMBERS ONLY DOGS ARE ALLOWED AT THE BEACH, 7 DAYS A WEEK, AT ANY TIME. DOGS MUST BE LEASHED, UNLESS SWIMMING. OWNER MUST CLEAN UP AFTER THEIR DOG." NO EXCEPTIONS.**

Boat Dock Regulations:

- a. The Dock Chairperson determines dock assignments.
 - i. When there are no unassigned spaces available on the dock, the members name will be put on a waiting list for a dock space on a first come, first serve basis.
- b. Boats must be registered in the member's name or in the name of one of the member's family.
- c. **Proof of Registration and Insurance must be presented to the current secretary, prior to launching the vessel each season.**
- d. There will be only one dock or mooring assignment per member household.

- i. If there are open spaces available, a member household may have one more.
 - ii. If a request for a dock space comes from a member household without a space, the member with an extra space will relinquish theirs. If there are multiple member households with two spaces, the member household who obtained their 2nd space last, shall relinquish theirs first.
- e. Members with boats on the docks are encouraged to participate in both the spring and fall workdays. Members who participate shall receive a \$25 discount on their dock charges for each day they work, maximum \$50.
- f. Children under 12 years of age are required to wear a coast guard approved life vest while on the docks.**
- g. All children 10 years and under will only be allowed on the docks with an adult.**
- h. There shall be no horseplay on the docks.
- i. People are only allowed to board boats at the invitation of their owners.
